



NOTICE OF ELECTION TO SEVIER COUNTY VOTERS

Notice is hereby given that candidates may file for the offices listed below for the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 in the following ways:

- i. The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates and local school board candidates begins on Monday, March 7, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 11, 2022; and,
 - ii. The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Friday, July 1, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Friday July 15, 2022; and,
 - iii. The Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins on Monday, January 3, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022; and
 - iv. Candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for the elective office.
1. Federal
 - a. U.S. Senate. One Senator for a six (6) year term.
 - b. U.S. House of Representatives. One representative from the Second District for a two (2) year term.
 2. State
 - a. State Executive. State Treasurer for a two (2) year term.
 - b. House of Representatives. One Representative for District #70 for a two (2) year term.
 3. County
 - a. County Officials for four (4) year terms.
 - I. Two (2) County Commissioners
 - II. County Attorney
 - III. County Clerk/Auditor
 - IV. County Sheriff
 4. School Board
 - a. State Board of Education. One Board member from District 14 for a four (4) year term.
 - b. County School Board. One Board member per Precinct for a four (4) year term from Precincts #1, #2, and #3.
 5. Judicial
 - a. Supreme Court. There will be an unopposed retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
 - b. Juvenile Court. There will be a retention election for one (1) Juvenile Court Judge in the Sixth District provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
 - c. Justice Court. There will be a retention election for two (2) Justice Court Judges in Sevier County provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
